

Using Photobucket to Post Photos

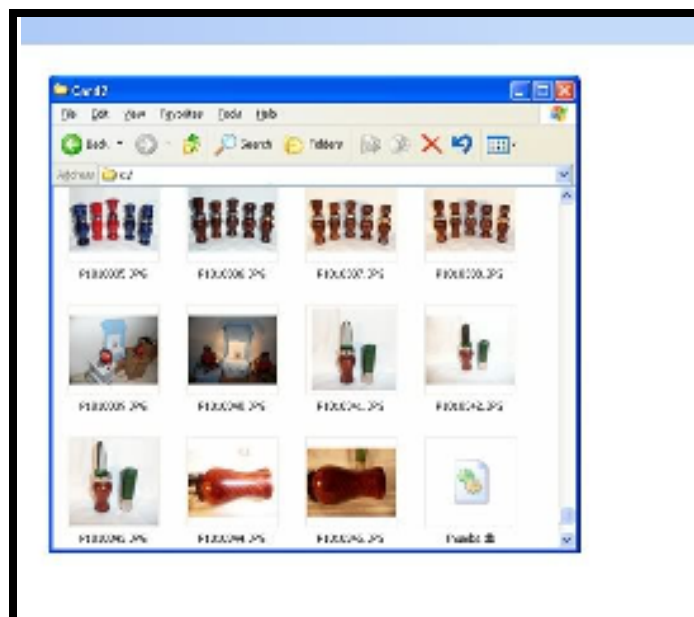

Here's how I post photo's using Photobucket.

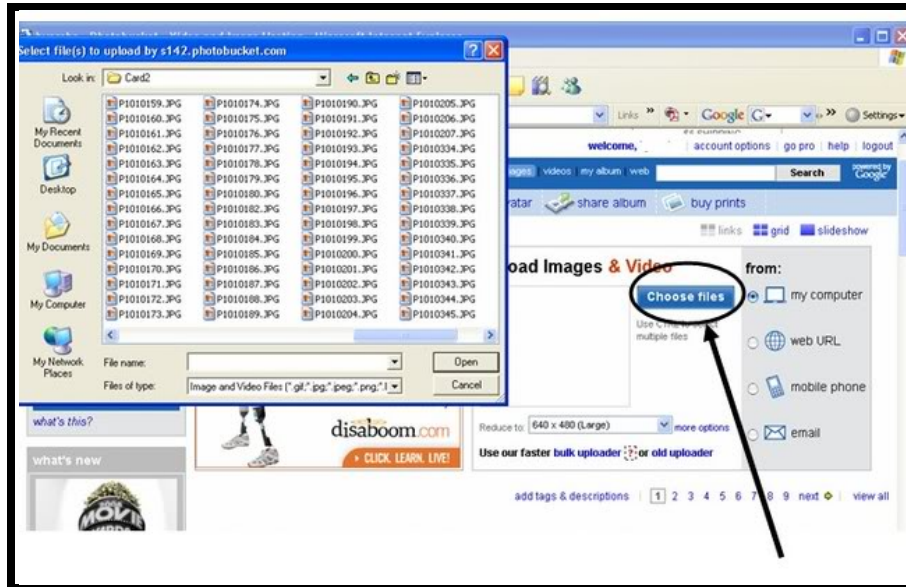
First, go to <http://photobucket.com/> and create a new account. Once you create an account, you will get a screen like this:



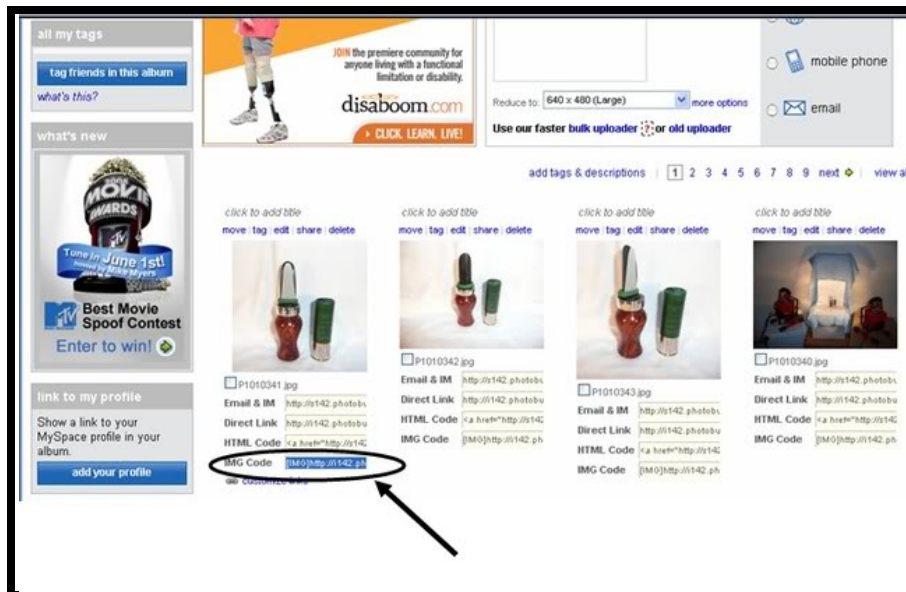
Next you need to locate the location of the photo's that you want to update. I usually have mine on my c: drive, and I like to show the thumbnails of the pics so I know what the photo looks like that is associated with the file name.



Then, you need to click on the box that says "Choose files" on the photobucket website. It is circled below. Once you click on it, a new window will pop up. Locate where the photos are at on your computer. Click on the photo files that you want to upload into photobucket, and hit open. They will then be automatically transferred into the photobucket website.



Once they are in photobucket, there are 4 lines below the photo. Click on the bottom line next to where it says IMG Code.



Once you click on that line, you will then click control-c to copy the link. All you have to do next is either right click or Control V and it will paste the link into a post on a thread. The code will look similar to {IMG}http://i142.photobucket.com/albums/{/IMG} except the {} will be replaced by [] when you are typing in the forum post. To see the photo in your post, you will need to either preview the post or actually make the post.
